

FCA LEADERSHIP TRAINING SCHOLARSHIP FUND

It is the conviction of many of our Fellowship that the need for encouraging the development of present and future leadership is of a critical nature. This Scholarship Fund has been developed in the interests of encouraging prospective leaders among our Fellowship (i.e. pastors, teachers, evangelists and church planters).

1. Qualifications for Scholarships

- The Candidate must be a sincere born again Christian.
- The Candidate must be endorsed by their home church.
- The Home Church must be a member of the Fellowship of Christian Assemblies and can include the church the candidate will be attending while in school.
- The References must include a recognized leader from the FCA home church and a personal reference from someone well acquainted with the candidate.
- The Candidate must demonstrate a genuine sense of commitment to service in Christian Leadership.
- The Candidate must be a person of integrity, honesty and faithfulness.
- The Candidate must demonstrate a consistent sense of Christian witness in their community.
- The Scholarship is only available to full time students who are entering their second (or subsequent) year of post-secondary Christian Education.

2. Procedure for obtaining a Scholarship

- The Candidate must complete an approved application form and submit it by June 30th.
- The Candidate must meet the above criteria.
- Representatives of the Scholarship Fund Committee shall determine eligibility for scholarships.
- The awarding of the Scholarship shall be during the annual Canadian convention of the Fellowship of Christian Assemblies or at another appropriate time as determined by the fund Committee.

3. The amount of the Scholarship

- Scholarships are presently awarded for \$1,500 each. The amount may be revised by the Scholarship Fund Committee based on the current cost of education, apparent need and availability of funds.

4. Funding

The Scholarship Fund shall be supported by the following:

- Donations from churches, individuals and businesses who show an interest in the objectives of this Fund.
- Bequests and wills.
- Alumni members of schools/colleges.
- Special fund raising projects by the fund committee, churches or interested individuals.

5. Organization

- The Scholarship Fund shall be administered by the Scholarship Fund Board.

6. Approved Colleges to which these funds may apply:

- Living Faith Bible College
- Amisk Lake Bible Academy
{special consideration will be given to the above two colleges, as they are accredited members of the FCA}
- Full Gospel Bible Institute, Eston, Saskatchewan
- Any of the Pentecostal Colleges of Canada {FCA, PAOC, ACOP, PH}
- Briercrest Bible College
- Peace River Bible Institute
- Providence College
- Regent College
- Trinity Western College
- Other institutions, which are not listed here, to which a student may wish to apply the scholarship would need to be presented to and approved by the Scholarship Fund Committee.
