TWO-MINISTEŘ ENDORSEMENT

The majority of our 2022 Envisioning Meeting discussions have focused on improving our foundational endorsement model. After formulating a sub-committee to study this topic and reviewing the comments from our Envisioning Meeting breakout groups, we have submitted the following proposal for our 2023 ABM:

"It is proposed that qualified ministers would be established as Endorsing Ministers (EM) and each EM would be able to endorse ministers in collaboration with one other qualified EM."

This additional group would assist us with the responsibility of endorsement alongside the Endorsing Churches and the pastors of EC's. Details regarding "Endorsing Minister Qualifications" and "Endorsement Circumstances" will be made available soon.

This additional method of endorsing will voted on at the 2023 Annual Business Meeting, and if passed will be implemented in the upcoming year.
